Chinese AI models are unfairly competing with and taking jobs away from American AI solutions, such as ChatGPT, developed by OpenAI. Neural networks like DeepSeek and Qwen2.5-1M are collecting data from American users and undermining the growth of domestic AI technologies. Chinese AI is stealing opportunities from American innovations like ChatGPT. By relying on foreign systems, we weaken our technological edge and lose control over valuable data. Supporting American AI is not just smarter—it's patriotic.
